Traffic Offenses Eligible for Michigan Basic Driver Improvement Course

The Michigan Basic Driver Improvement Course (BDIC) allows eligible drivers to avoid points on their driving record and prevent the ticket information from being sent to their auto insurance company.

To be eligible for BDIC, you must meet all of the following requirements:

- You have a valid, non-commercial drivers license.
- You have zero, one, or two points on your driving record.
- You have not previously avoided points with BDIC.
- The violation was not committed in a commercial vehicle.
- The violation was not a criminal offense.
- The violation was for three or fewer points.

In addition, the violation must be on the approved list of BDIC-eligible violations. You can find the list on the following pages.
